The purpose of this beautification program is to promote a cleaner environment within the Martindale-Brightwood Community. Working in conjunction with the City of Indianapolis, the Department of Public Waste, Keep Indianapolis Beautiful, Inc. and other sponsors, the CDC encourages neighbors to implement their own beautification strategy to keep their respective blocks clear of debris year-round. However, this one-time CDC-assisted effort is meant to jumpstart individualized and overall neighborhood clean-up campaigns. In order for your group’s application to be considered for the assistance lottery, all sections must be completed in full and to the best knowledge of submitting applicants. Martindale-Brightwood Community Beautification Assistance Program Guidelines

The Martindale-Brightwood Community Development Corporation, in conjunction with other, sponsoring City organizations is offering community residents the opportunity to host a clean-up campaign in their neighborhood. Residents interested in applying for assistance are encouraged to fill out the attached application and submit it to our office. Dumpsters and other clean-up supplies will be provided free of charge for the event.

Program Guidelines

- The neighborhood beautification program is intended for use by Martindale-Brightwood residents only.
- Should your group's application be accepted, a minimum of four weeks advance notice is required to promote and plan the clean-up event.
- The neighborhood's clean-up coordinator must assist in providing event information to all homes in the scheduled clean-up area.
- Clean-up events are not intended for individual home use. Promotion of the program is necessary to ensure the largest turnout possible.
- Normal clean-up events scheduled to take place on Saturdays, typically beginning at 8 a.m.
- A maximum of two 40-cubic yard dumpsters will be delivered to clean-up area prior to the event. These dumpsters are not intended to be used for disposal of large rehab or landscaping waste. Disposal of solvents, hazardous waste or tires is prohibited.
- In order to limit additional filling of our public landfill, the neighborhood coordinator should assess the materials to be disposed of and make diversions if possible. For example, furniture, clothing and other items may be diverted from being placed in the landfill and instead be donated to local charities and thrift stores. Many such organizations will even gladly pick up these items if given notice.
